Upon consideration of the “Motion for Special Admission of Out-of-State Attorney Under Rule 19-217(b)” filed in the above-captioned case on August 9, 2024, by James Dold, counsel for *amicus curiae*, Human Rights for Kids, for the special admission of Adam C.
